

An Acc^t. of M^r Goring's Title to the Manor of Balneth

An Acc^t. how George Goring Esq^e. of Ades derives his Pedigree from S^r. W^m. Goring K^{nt}. to whom King Edw^d. the 6th. Granted the Mannors of Balneth and to the Heirs Male of his Body. And how he now claims the said Estate (on the death of S^r. W^m. Goring Bar^t. lately deceased) by virtue of that Entayle.

Note The said Sr. Wm. Goring (the common Ancestor) dyed on or about the year 1553 leaving Henry Goring his Eldest Son and Heir who dyed about the year 1594 leaving Issue two Sons viz. W^m. Goring and Edward Goring.

NB Sr. Harry Goring of Highdean Bar^t. puts in his Claime to the same Estate as a Descendant from the said Edw^d. Goring who was youngest Son of the aforesaid Henry.

The Pedigree and Title

W^m. Goring (Eldest Son and Heir of Henry Goring Esq^e.) was Married about the 24th of January 1563 to Anne the Daughter of Robert Burbage by whom he had Issue – S^r. Henry Goring his Son and Heir, Baptized about the 23rd of August 1573. And the said W^m. (on the Death of the said Anne) remarried with Margaret the Daughter of Richard Challoner by whom he left Issue – one Son named George.

Note This S^r. Henry Goring was the Great Grandfather to the last S^r. W^m. Goring.

The said George Goring Married Catharine the Daughter of Richard Cheyney Esq^e. and left Issue 4 Sons viz. George, Edward, Thomas, and John.

Vide Chart 3^o. Oct^{bris}. 44^o. Eliz [44th year of Elizabeth's reign, i.e., 1602] being a Settlement made on the said George Goring & Catharine his wife of several Lands in Barcombe Hamsey and Newick. And made between Henry Goring of Burton Esq^e. (son and Heir of W^m. Goring late of Burton Esq^e. deceased) and Eleanor his wife, the said George Goring (Brother to the said Henry Goring and 2 Son of the said W^m. Goring) and Catharine his wife daughter of Richard Cheyney late of Crawley Esq^e. deceased and others.

George (Eldest Son of the aforesaid George) dyed without Issue.

Edward the 2^d. Son dyed also without Issue.

Thomas the 3^d. Son dyed without Issue.

John the 4th. Son Married Eleanor the Daughter ofGarret and left Issue 2 Sonns viz. George and Edward.

George was Baptized about the 5th Feb^{ry}. 1645 and Married 2 Wives viz. the first was Elizth. the Daughter of M^r. John Newnham by whom he left Issue One Son named George who is ye Gentleman [?] now Claims the Balneth Estate as next Heir Male to ye last S^r. W^m. Goring.

The aforesaid George Goring's 2^d. wife was Elizabeth the Daughter of M^r Mill by whom he left Issue One Son named John now living at Barcombe.

Edward Goring youngest Son of the aforesaid John Goring was Baptized about the year 1657 but dyed without Issue.

N. B The aforesaid Thomas Goring by his last Will and Testament dated about the 8th. of June 1667. Did Give and Devise the Mannor of Barcombe [?] To the aforesaid George Goring his Nephew Eldest Son of the aforesaid John Goring his Brother.

A List of the persons Names who have been Lords of the Mannor
of Barcombe for 185 years and upwards.

S^r Nicholas Carew was Lord thereof the 16th. April 29th. King H:8 [year may be incorrect] and so continued till after the 22^o. Oct^{bris}. 30 H:8 [year may be incorrect as he was executed in March 1539].

The said King H:8 was Lord thereof and held a Court the 23^o. April 30th year of his Reign [1539]. The said Mannor being forfeited to him on the s^d. [said] S^r. Nicholas Carew being Attainted of High Treason.

Elizth. Carew Widow of the s^d. S^r. Nicholas (the s^d. King H:8 having regranted the s^d. Mannor back again) and held Courts there from the 10^o. Sept^{bris}. 31th. year of the Reign of K:H:8 [1540] to the 26th. April 32 H:8 [1541].

Francis Carew was Lord thereof from that time till after the 22^o. Oct^{bris}. the 2 year of [?] Reign of K. Edw. 6th. [1548]

After w^{ch}. [which] the s^d. Mannor came to George Goring 2^d Son of the first S^r. W^m. Goring who held a Court there from the 7^o. March 1572 till the 9th. April 1579.

William Goring Nephew to the s^d. George Goring was Lord thereof from 20th. April 1582 to 10th. Jan^{ry}. 1594.

After w^{ch}. George Goring 2 Son of afs^d. W^m. Goring was Lord thereof from 16th. July 1640 to [?] 4th. July 1651.

Edw^d. Goring 2^d Son of the s^d. George was Lord thereof from the 5th. Sept. 1653 to the 26th. Oct. 1658.

Thomas Goring 3^d Son of the s^d. George was Lord thereof from 18th. April 1664 to the 13th. Oct. 1668.

George Goring Nephew of the s^d. Tho^s. and Eldest Son of John Goring 4th. Son of the s^d. George Goring was Lord thereof from the 24th. March 1669 to the 14th. July 1714.

And from thence to George Goring Eldest Son of the last George Goring (by Elizth. Newnham his 1st. wife) who is now living and Lord of the said Mannor.
